We have enjoyed getting to know her and having her as a part of our church family, even if it was only short-term.

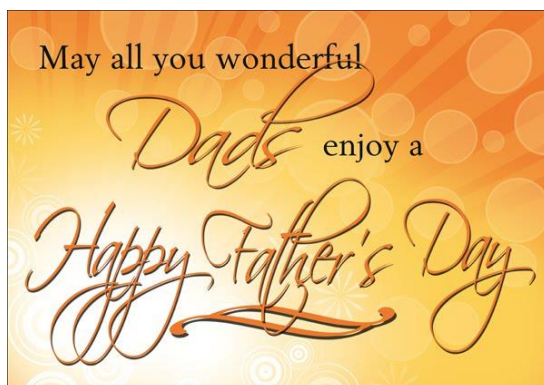


The second celebration will be on 07/09 to welcome Pastor Karen Sorden as our new Pastor here at CSUMC. We look forward to meeting and getting to know her.
