VBS Mission - Our Vacation Bible School mission project was Heifer Project. So far the

children and families have raised over \$200.00. If you want to give to this, we will accept your contributions through the month of August. Thank you for your support and at the end of the month we will let you know how many chickens, goats, or pigs we funded.

Missions - continued: We will continue collecting supplies for the School Bags. Now is the time to get what we need to send these to places where the chance to go to school gives hope to the child and his/her family. We hope to pack at least 200 bags. Supplies still needed are: 24 ct. Crayons – 20 more boxes, 70 page spiral bound notebooks – 210 needed, 12 in. rulers- 75 needed, and unsharpened pencils – still need 150 more six packs. If you'd rather give money, it will be used to purchase the supplies or for shipping the finished bags. Place items in the tubs on each level or in the Office. Thank you for all your donations.
